MtA Keith, 2nd Charlie, accepted unanimously

- A93 Chair Rudy - visiting districts. Gave an Area overview. 103 cities, 1,013 groups + 500 unknown (no GSR or inactive), 25 Districts (8 Hispanic). Shared his story and inspiration for General Service.
- IG AV: Keith - we are still losing money and likely to close within 1 year. Down \$19k YTD so far. Please remind groups to contribute and about the current fundraiser.
- SCV: Judy - started Faithful Fivers, more than 10 ppl. in first few weeks. Contributions are up a little.
- DCM - we need to switch our mindsets to 1 drink in the basket, not \$1. GSRs make it known to your groups.
- YPAA Tyler - Fat Spiritual Lines 2nd anniversary 10/19, Road Course event Anaheim 10/21, Halloween in Oceanside 10/28, Day of the Dead, Bakersfield 11/4. Still no website yet. Instagram is up.
- H&I AV: Carolyn - AVRU H&I speaker from Knoxville was great. Had a great table at the round up with visitors from other areas.
- Chili Cook-off is coming 11/11.
- DCM - H&I member has brought up that inmates are looking for sponsorship and is putting together a list of willing participants. Originally it was started with snail mail, now they have ipads. There is a small fee (.05c / text)
- Registrar Keith H. - everyone except Tyler has now been submitted to GSO, but not everyone has received their packets yet.
